Stocks wiz Tony Measor passes away

Local finance guru and former business news editor at The Standard Tony Measor died at home yesterday of respiratory illness. He was 82.

Vincent Lam Siu-yeung, managing director of VL Asset Management and a protege of Measor, said his demise comes as a significant loss to locals who benefited from trading tips he used to share through his columns.

Between 1996 and 2010, Measor wrote a column for investors for Next Magazine. At one stage, the value of the investment portfolio in his column went up by nine times, underscoring the soundness of his picks.

Following his stint at The Standard, he became a fund manager before taking up the post of chief editor at Quamnet, a financial data provider.
